Avery's core business model was originally focused on B2B (Business to Business) sales, but in an ever-changing environment the company has invested into an E-Commerce and D2C (Direct to Consumer) offering, resulting in rapid expansion of some of its brands such as Avery WePrint. This expansion has meant that its manufacturing ERP system (QAD) needs to be able to support the changing external systems driving the E-Commerce and online experience.

The Role:

We are looking to recruit an experienced ERP specialist to work within the existing ERP team and who can help us customise and develop our ERP system (QAD) to fit our growing business needs. The role will suit an IT professional with experience writing reports and customisations to ERP end users as well as an understanding of how to utilise tools to import and export data between systems.

Similarly to how SAP uses the ABAP programming language, QAD uses the Progress 4GL programming language to develop reports and interfaces. Knowledge of the Progress 4GL programming language is not essential however experience with a similar language (such as ABAP) is.

Required Skills:

- Understanding of databases with the ability to query and update data (SQL or similar database)
- Good programming skills with ability to write programs and reports within an ERP system
- Experience developing and deploying solutions from development to production environments
- Experience testing solutions with an analytical mindset to find root causes of issues
- Good communication skills to understand existing workflows
